Command Chief Master Sergeant Michael J. Bouley is the senior enlisted advisor for the 192nd Fighter Wing, Virginia Air National Guard at Langley AFB, Virginia. He advises the wing commander on matters influencing the health, welfare, morale and effective utilization of nearly 1,000 enlisted members.

Bouley grew up in Vernon, Connecticut, and Wallingford, Vermont. He entered the Air Force in July, 1979. Upon graduating from technical school as a jet engine specialist at Chanute Air Force Base, Illinois, his assignments included Hahn Air Base, Germany, and Bergstrom Air Force Base, Texas, working on F-4E and RF-4C aircraft.



After his tour in the active duty Air Force, Bouley joined the 158th Fighter Wing, Vermont Air National Guard in 1989 as a jet engine intermediate maintenance guardsman working on F-16A/B aircraft. In 1991, Bouley joined the Virginia Air National Guard as the 192nd Fighter Wing was converting to F-16C/D aircraft. During his tenure in the Vermont and Virginia Air National Guards, Bouley volunteered for stateside and overseas deployments, such as Operations IRAQI FREEDOM, PROVIDE COMFORT, NOBLE EAGLE and exercises including Red Flags, Maple Flags, Combat Hammers and Combat Archers. Since January 2006, Bouley has facilitated the first fighter integration effort between the 1st Fighter Wing and the 192nd Fighter Wing maintenance teams at Joint Base Langley-Eustis, Virginia. He is married and has two children.
